The 6 Days Between Lessons

Encouraging them to play and have fun during their "review" time at home not only fosters their creativity but also strengthens their confidence and self-reliance. It's an essential part of their musical development.

Your support and enthusiasm for their musical pursuits makes all the difference, and we believe that allowing them the space to explore and learn on their own will lead to even more rewarding musical experiences.
